

## **Definition of Umbrella Organisation**

## Description

DeafCOG, (Deaf Cultural Outreach Group), is:

An **umbrella organisation** that hosts activities and projects of value to the Deaf community. The aim is to promote the Deaf identity positively; to create opportunities; to strengthen the community; and to provide community-led services in British Sign Language (BSL) and Deaf culture.

## What is an 'umbrella organisation'?

A central coordinating organisation that represents a group of smaller, independent bodies or individuals.

An association of (often related, industry specific) institutions, who work together formally to co-ordinate activities or pool resources, sometimes the arrangement is for the umbrella organisation, to some degree, to be responsible for the groups under its care, but not always.

## The benefits include:

- The ability to carry out activities which could not be carried out alone due to size and composition of individual or smaller businesses.
- A better pool of experts and experience that can be shared to raise all enterprise within the industry, which ensures customer satisfaction.
- A sense of community having a shared goal and positive attitudes towards each other, upskilling those within to business community, which in turn benefits the service / end user.
- Safeguarding compliance with the law of any business activities.
- Ensuring value and quality.
